

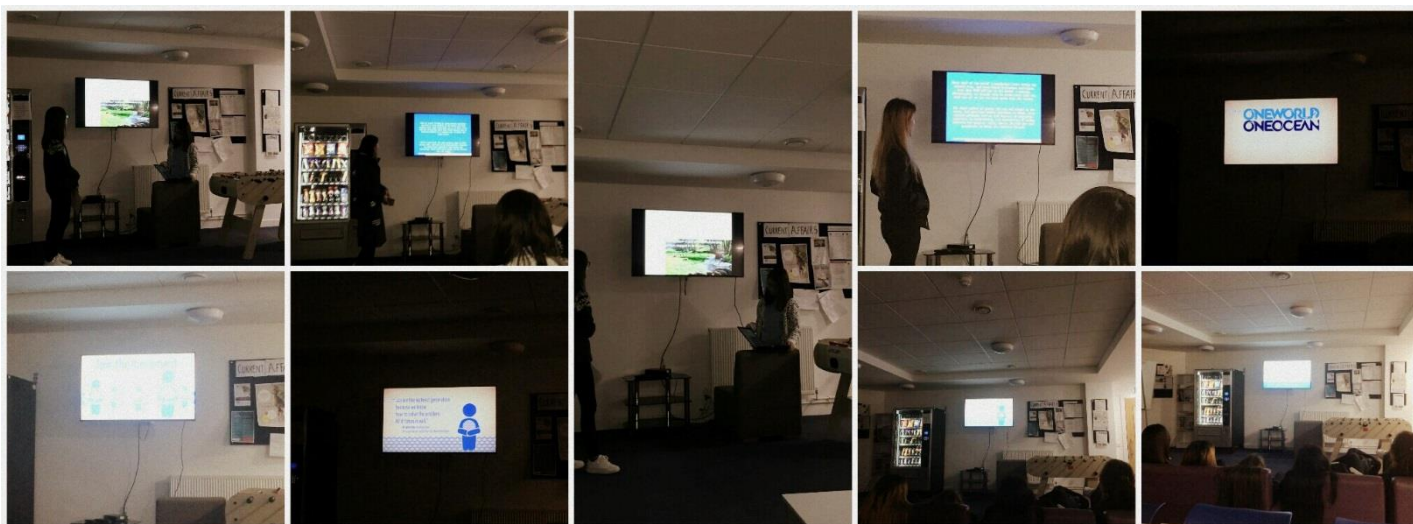


UPDATE:
