Improve your English language skills and learn about the famous tale through course-related trips and visits to the historical places of Oxford.



Briefly about Cherwell College Oxford

Located in the historic centre of Oxford, Cherwell College is a co-educational boarding and day school for students aged between 12 - 18 years of age.

The College follows the Oxbridge-style tutorial method of teaching, which is considered as the gold-standard of British education system.

This approach to education helps students to have their unique needs met and engage deeply with their tutors and subject material. Students develop an enthusiasm for learning, a curious mind, and a responsible approach to academic studies.

During the term time, the College offers a range of UK curriculum programmes that are aimed at preparing students for entry to top higher education institutions.















§ Boarding

Cherwell College offers excellent accommodation facilities for residential full-time and short-term students.

The boarding facilities comprise of 55 single ensuite study bedrooms with all the modern amenities:

- En-suite (single) student rooms with private bathroom;
- Full-board catering (freshly prepared meals);
- Student common area with TV and board games;
- Laundry room;
- Medical room;
- Outside garden for alfresco activities (e.g. ping pong, badminton) and BBQ (!)

The residential welfare team responsible for students' pastoral care and well-being (the so-called 'house parents') permanently reside on campus.

11:00 – 11:30	Refreshment break
11:30 – 13:00	Study period
13:00 – 14:00	Lunch
14:00 – 16:00	Study period/theme-specific workshops
16:00 – 18:00	Free time
18:00 – 19:00	Dinner
19:00 – 21:00	Evening activities
21:30	Curfew

On Saturdays and Sundays, students will take an organised trip to local historical sites in Oxford/Oxfordshire/Buckinghamshire or Berkshire counties.

On the last Friday of each course session, there will be a 'farewell' dinner or BBO (weather permitting).

- CHRIST CHURCH COLLEGE (one of the 39 colleges of the University of Oxford the 'birth place' of Alice!)








The courses are to run during a 2-week period as follows:
