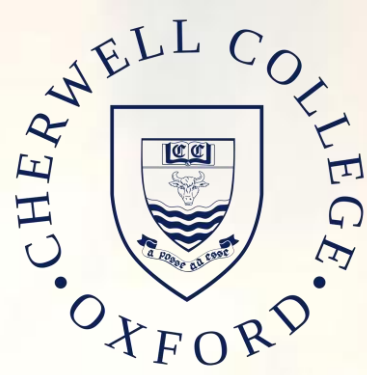

Briefly about **Cherwell College Oxford**

Located in the historic centre of Oxford, Cherwell College has educated many generations of students for the life beyond school, providing educational solutions appropriate to their academic or career aspirations.

The College follows the **Oxbridge-style tutorial method of teaching**, which is considered as the gold-standard of British education system.

Like the Oxford colleges, Cherwell remains deliberately 'small but beautiful', not exceeding an overall number of 100 students in each particular year. Approximately 50 are full-time or weekly boarders, accommodated at the College's purpose-built students' residence – Cherwell House, Osney Lane, Oxford.

Increasingly we observe young people indecisive about their academic or career aspirations, unable to make a firm decision about what they wish to pursue at a university or in life beyond school. Young people conflicted about their role in the world of emerging industries and technologies. 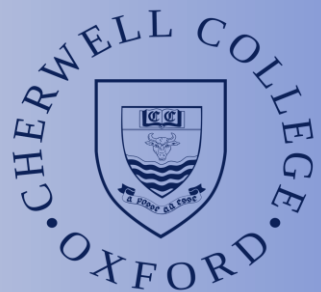
What will the programme look like?

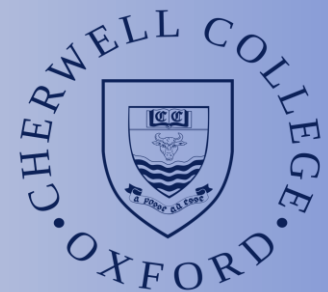

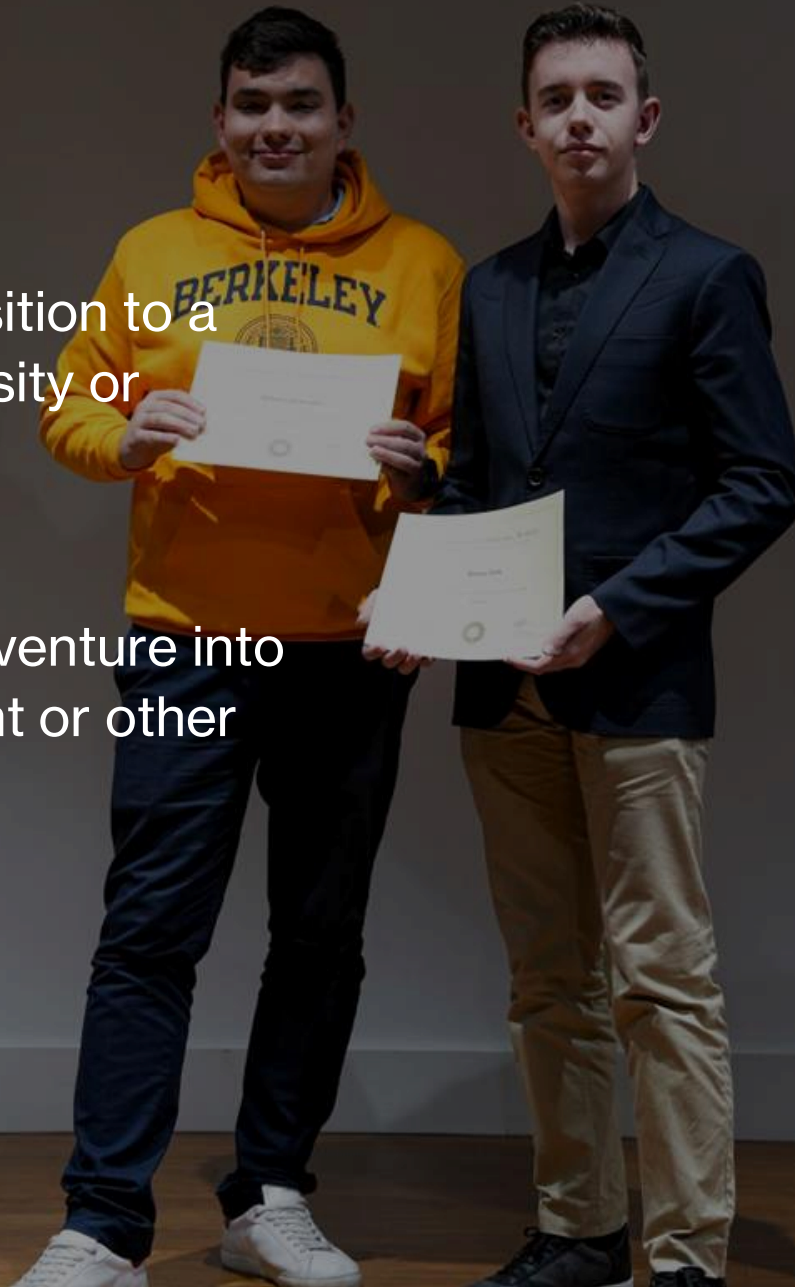
Progression Routes

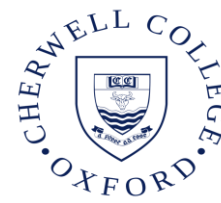
Oleksandr, former Cherwellian and BMoE participant:

I want to share several lessons:

- 1. Be mindful of your time. It's common here to have 15-minute meetings, so you really want to concentrate on important takeaways and avoid the BS.*
- 2. People here are mindful of their time, leading to a focus on extracting value and providing it in return. You'll receive genuinely good advice, but it's also expected that you'll be open to giving value back if the situation arises.*
- 3. With such a focus on time and value, there's a rapid learning curve. You start gaining experiences and launching products much faster than almost anywhere else in the world, emphasizing again the importance of being mindful of time.*

Silicon Valley is essentially about competition bolstered by a supportive community, with the potential to reward significant achievements with astonishing benefits.
